
Wednesday, March 27 at 5:30 p.m. in the annex

- 2. Posters and post cards: The Sul Ross Print Shop has been hired to produce 30–11" x 17" color posters and 100–4" x 6" post cards. - 3. *Radio spots*: We will begin running 3 x 30 second spots before morning, noon, and evening news broadcasts each day on station KVLF (1240 AM) beginning April 18 through and including April 27.
- 4. Newspaper ad and free article/community calendar: We will use both commercial and community event sections in the *Alpine Avalanche*. We will run a 3" x 5" ad the week of April 1 followed by a 1/4 page ad the week of April 22.
