

### What is the “zipper” strategy?

Texas public school bus drivers practice emergency exits with school children using the zipper idea. We exit the church building using a similar approach.

Church members and visitors exit the building starting from the back of the auditorium. One side (#1), then the other (#2), then the other side (#3), until all the people exit the auditorium.

The plan helps organize the exit allowing the social distancing to continue.

# We are meeting this Sunday!

Sunday, May the 10th we will meet as an assembled church.  
Feel welcome to call Curtis with suggestions/concerns.

### Guidelines for Sunday, May 10th:

1. Meet at 10:45am for worship only (no Bible classes and no Sunday evening worship).
2. Stay home if you have an illness or high -risk condition that could jeopardize your health and safety.
3. Expect a friendly greeter who provides a “single serve communion set” and a bulletin. A collection box is available in the back of the auditorium.
4. Consider wearing a mask.
5. Keep a social distance.
5. Try the elbow pump instead of hugging and shaking hands.
8. Sit as a family unit and distance yourself from other families leaving one pew empty in front and behind you.
9. Conduct targeted dismissal from the assembly. Will use the “zipper” strategy when leaving (to be explained).
10. Sanitize or wash your hands when entering or leaving the building.
