The laws of teaching stated as rules:

1. Know thoroughly and familiarly the lesson you wish to teach—teach from a full mind and a clear understanding.
2. Gain and keep the attention and interest of the pupils.
3. Use words understood by the pupils and teacher.
4. Begin with what is already known.
5. Stimulate the pupil’s own mind to action.
6. Require the pupil to reproduce in thought the lesson he is learning.
7. Review, review, review.
