





Future Planned Meetings

Those in attendance voted to keep the 9:45 am Bible Class time and the 10:45 am Worship time. The discussion continued as to options of more meetings times moving forward.

Susie Liddell shared that it's sometimes difficult for those who live out of town to come back at 6:00 pm on Sunday's or Wednesday nights. Zach and Stacy shared that the first half of the day works best for their families as they live more than 15-miles outside of the city limits.

The group voted to not continue with the old schedule of 6:00 pm Sunday evening services but rather move forward with a 1:00 pm class time. This will be similar to the First Principles class that Curtis recently led. Depending on the week/month, the group can decide to do a full potluck or BYOL. The first 1:00 pm Sunday class time has not yet been set.

The group also voted to not continue with a Wednesday night service for now, but for everyone to work on fellowshiping and studying during the week.

Vacation Bible School (VBS)

Curtis' questions regarding VBS were 1) will we have a VBS this year? 2) do we continue the "drive-through" concept or do we meet in-person?

Caleb Hughes recommended that the church host an in-person VBS; Nicholas was thrilled to hear about another VBS. Susie voted that we go for it.

After discussion on timing, the group tentatively scheduled the next in-person VBS for **Saturday, August 14, 2021**. Kayla shared ideas for topics with the group.
