



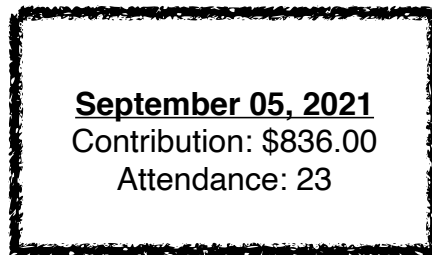

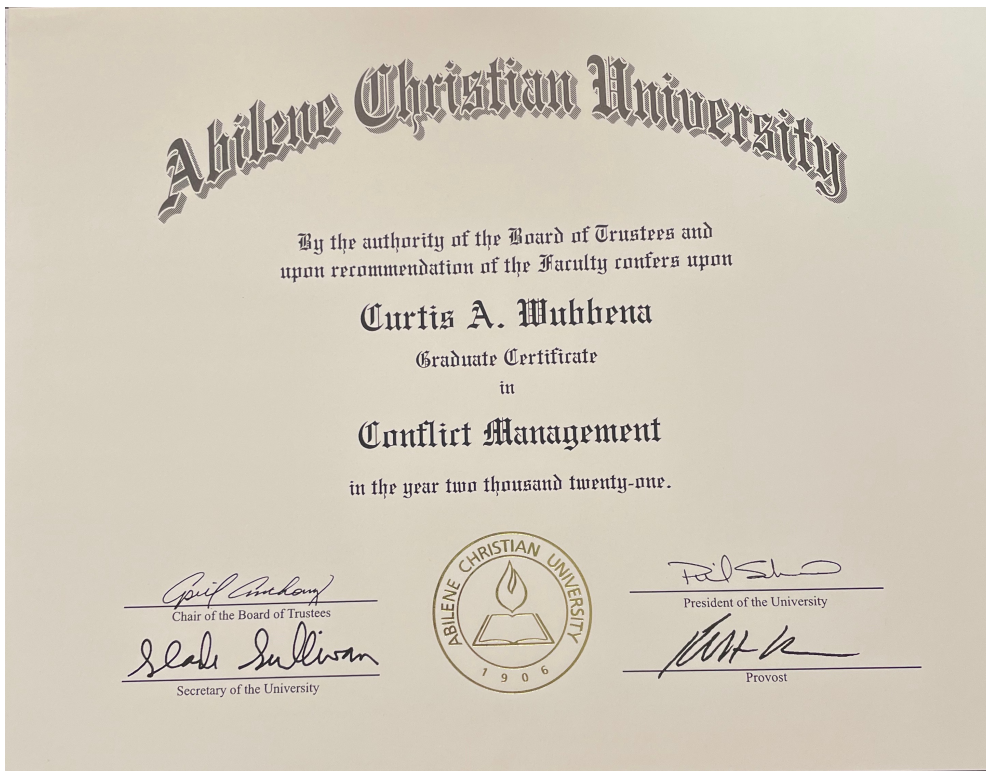
It's not that dirty a job, but somebody has to do it. Looking for a way to serve? The baptistery needs draining and cleaning every two months. See Curtis if you would like to help.



The Post Park, Marathon, Texas

A spring-fed oasis in the desert awaits those that venture to the Post Park south of Marathon. Though no established hiking trails exist within the park, it is still a great place to unwind in the solitude that far west Texas has to offer. Before it was a county park, Camp Peña Colorado as it was then known served as an outpost to the US Army for a number of years in the 1800s, with the Native Americans in the area making use of it for an untold length of time before then. If you are a birder, do not forget to bring a camera, as hundreds of feathered friends can be seen taking advantage of the natural resource. The Post Park also has many outdoor tables to have a picnic at, with the French Co. Grocer in Marathon being a great place to stock up on vittles for your outing. The Post Park is about five miles south of Marathon, Texas, and can be reached by turning south on Avenue D. Marathon is about 31 miles east of Alpine, and is an easy daytrip while you're in the area.
