

What We Believe

Since the Bible is the inspired, inerrant, guide for our relationships with each other and the community, we seek teaching and preaching that illuminates ways of improving each Christian's walk with God. The Bible enhances the life of the reader by revealing God's eternal plan to help people. It also discloses what life could be like without sin through the example of Jesus Christ. When Jesus left heaven, he embraced a human form, living the life of God on earth. Jesus' words, actions, and thoughts are at our fingertips through the study of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Our Mission

Our mission is to encourage consistent, godly living in individual members, so our community may experience the wisdom of God through us. Humbleness seems appropriate since we still are sinners. The advantage of being a baptized believer is forgiveness through the blood of Christ, continued forgiveness through Jesus as our high priest, and advocacy by Christ on the Day of eternal judgment.
