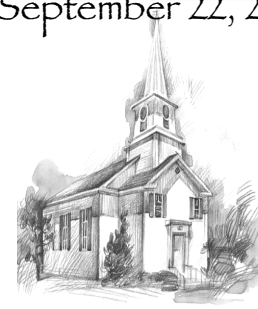

Also, suggested for improvement, is that there is always, more than one person heading up or considered a contact, for these types of things.
- 3.) We could benefit from being more organized, in how we help others. Example: Signing up to take meals to someone who's had a baby or surgery.
- 4.) We could benefit from more prayer time with one another. Meeting together, just to pray, especially for specific concerns (a person's health, seeking direction in how we operate, a major event, like recent church shooting, etc.). This could include a special meeting time, at regular intervals (monthly, quarterly), and/or immediately, as needed (finding out a member has been in a life threatening car accident, etc.)
