Wissam's progress in Detroit as of October

While I was out of town, several co-laborers of mine set up a table with Christian literature on it in a park in Dearborn that happened to be across the street from a school. An angry local took a photo of the table. Days later, a detective called one laborer telling him that "a few feathers were ruffled" although he assured the that his First Amendment rights were properly preserved. Another few days later (though in a separate incident,) that friend of mine was arrested at the Wayne State University campus for organizing a Muslim-Christian meeting. I have therefore put the park outreach on hold before its traditional ending with the end of Detroit's short summer after handing Christian literature with one last Lebanese young man.

Meanwhile in *Cape Girardeau, MO*, a local mosque distributed Islamic literature to the kids of a local school. I learned that during my engagement there where I presented *Islam in Christ's Eyes* for three days. The small community was as engaged as it was hospitable, and a few of them requested a copy of *The Road to Your Happiness* to share with their Muslim neighbors. The book is available for free in two languages upon request and is a very popular handout among Muslims and Christians alike.
