Welcome back, from my first full day home after our Egypt tour. We visited the historical sites of the country's rich history and yet another part of the Bible unfolded like a living pop-up book. The tour (which had three ACM members and another 47 pilgrims) lasted two weeks and was a blessing to the visitors, the visited and those with whom we will share stories. I wrote an update for each day on social media and I will start writing a pictorial book on all my visits to the Bible lands.

A Chinese congregation visited Dearborn on a mission trip and I had the privilege of speaking to them. we also shared the gospel with as many souls as the Lord has disposed in the University of Michigan's Dearborn campus (~3,000 Arab Muslim students.) The congregation also visited our Friday's music outreach and had nothing short of a good report in their update.

I was also invited to speak at the *Oscoda Church of Christ's* gospel meeting and was invited to speak at Alpena and Schwartz Creek congregations.

A Texas brother met a Muslims man "desiring to know more about Christianity." A copy of *The Road to Your Happiness* was promptly mailed to him. You also get a free copy of the book that is written in English and Arabic if you need one.

It was the largest crowd this humble house of mine has had since I moved into it eight years ago. Fourteen Christians attended a time-travel *Bible tour* where we virtually visited the times when the Bible was revealed, written, compiled and canonized. The evening concluded with the *Jesus* musical and was a joy in the heart of every visitor.

A Christian brother honored me with his invitation to speak at his media ministry.

After more than ten months since the parliamentary election, Iraq has finally formed its government. The country has been doing so well on so many levels during the political vacuum it had the fastest growing economy in the Arab world according to the IMF. It looks like the Iraq tour is a go for March 7. If you have half as much fun as we had last year, you are in for a big treat. I will create a WhatsApp group for the prospective visitors by the end of this month.

Next, I'll be in Virginia for an Arab Christian singing event, then the *Alpena Church of Christ* on November 6.

And finally, the contributions for the past month have totaled \$1,680 against a minimalist budget of \$2,200. and once again this work will continue as long as it is supported.
