Timeline

Preaching and teaching Sunday morning class and assembly:

1. Preach September 10, 17, 24, and off on the 3rd. Curtis arranges for someone to preach and teach the morning class on the 3rd.
2. Preach October 1, 8, 15, 22, and off on the 29th. Curtis arranges for someone to preach and teach the morning class on the 29th.
3. Preach November 5, 12 and off on the 19th and 26th. Men of the congregation arrange for someone to preach and teach the morning classes on the 19th and the 26th.
4. Preach December 3, 10, and 17 and off on the 24th and the 31st. Men of the congregation arrange for someone to preach and teach the morning classes on the 19th and the 26th.

Bulletin creation, publication, and distribution and website posting/updating:

1. September-Curtis creates, publishes, and distributes the bulletin.
2. October- Curtis creates, publishes, and distributes the bulletin.
3. November-Men of the congregation secure a family to take over bulletin production. Curtis collaborates with the family until the family can take over production.
4. December-new publishing family does the bulletin in December.

Checking the church mail at the post office and relaying mail to Stacy: Stacy has taken over checking the church mail.

Caleb Hughes begins working with the church as minister on January 1, 2024.
