


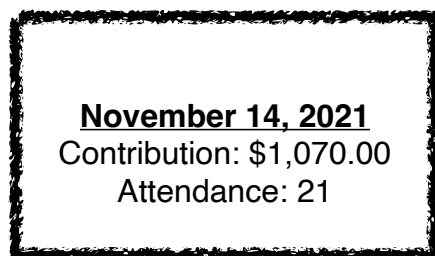

Boquillas Canyon

Skirting along the park's southeastern edge, Boquillas Canyon is both the deepest and the longest of the three main canyons within Big Bend National Park. Here, folks have the chance to take in the serenity of a desert riparian environment as the Rio Grande makes its way through Boquillas' high canyon walls, parts of which reach upwards of 1200 ft. A great option to consider if planning a float trip, the canyon itself is about 20 miles in length, with about 33 river miles between the Rio Grande Village put-in and Heath Canyon Ranch take-out spots. Numerous guide services and river outfitters exist in the area, though adequately prepared visitors may go it alone with relative ease of mind as the rapids along this stretch of river only rank up to Class II. A three or four night trip is the ideal length of time to devote to this outing, allowing the perfect chance to take in the low desert scenery while camping next to the river. If looking into guide services, [Far Flung Outfitters](#)

based in Terlingua would be a recommended choice offering fair pricing, knowledgeable and wilderness first aid/CPR trained staff, and a shuttle service to and from put-in and take-out spots. If a river trip is not in the plans, visitors can also hike an easy mile-and-a-half trail leading to the canyon's mouth, or take in spectacular views atop the formidable Marufo Vega Loop Trail nearby. To find out more information on float trips and current Rio Grande water levels, Far Flung Outfitters may be reached by calling 432-371-2633. Any pertinent alerts or notices can be found by calling the park at 432-477-2251.

From the Alpine Church of Christ building, it's about 120 miles to Rio Grande Village where food, laundry, showers, and gas are available. Boquillas Canyon is a short four mile jaunt from Rio Grande Village. The outpost also offers camping and RV hookups, but can be one of the more crowded sites in the park, so book accordingly. A better option may be the Candelilla campsite off of nearby Old Ore Road. (Joe Ed)
